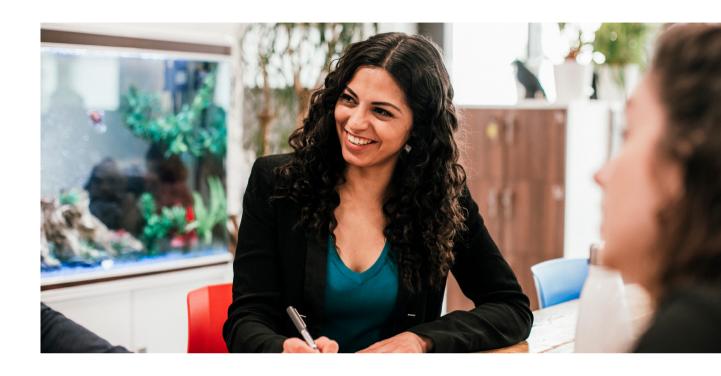

For one client in the social care sector, it meant reducing Child in Need and Child Protection caseload numbers by 29%.

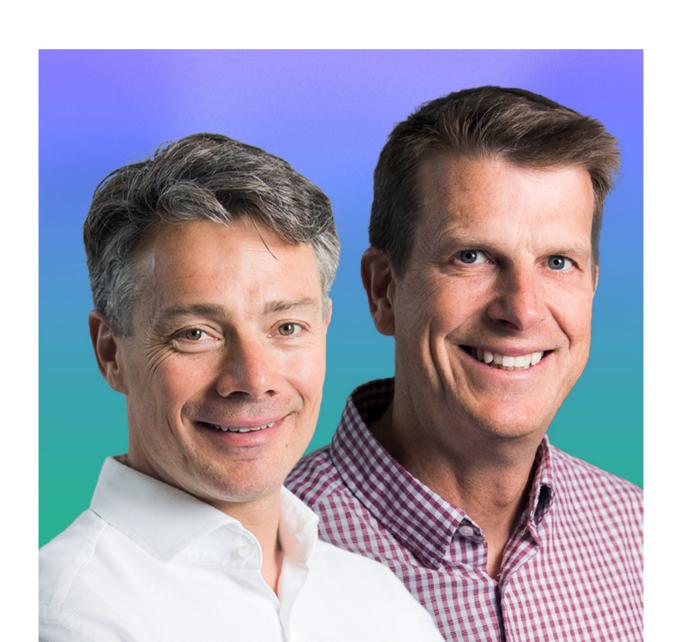
For another in the retail sector, it meant growing revenues by £250 million and fundamentally changing the way 80,000 people work.

OUR STORY



It all began in 2001, with our founders, Tom Wedgwood, Kevin Jones and Andy Hawes. They believed that no consultancy should be paid unless it delivered measurable results. So, they created Newton to do just that.

TWO DECADES OF FIRSTS...

Since then, the milestones have flown past.

In 2008, we delivered our first project in the public sector. In 2014, we delivered our first £100 million project. By 2016, we'd helped one of the UK's leading supermarkets unlock around £100 million of opportunity every year. Then, as part of the COVID-19 response in 2020, we worked with a consortium of UK firms to design, develop and deliver 11,500 ventilators in just 12 weeks.

...WITH MORE TO COME

And we just keep on growing. We now have almost 500 people, working together to crack some of the nation's toughest challenges.

DIGITAL CONSULTANTS

As the name suggests, this role has a digital focus. Concentrating on the technology clients use, the data they generate and how that data can provide new insights into their biggest challenges, you'll have a key role to play in bridging the gap between IT and Operations to deliver sustainable results. Delivering on that promise can be as complex as it is technically demanding, but you'll have all the training and support you need. And in doing so, you'll help to keep clients — and Newton — at the forefront of the digital revolution.

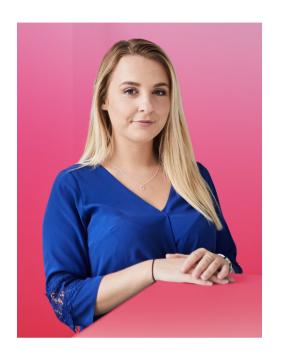


HEAD OFFICE GRADUATES

OUR TRAINING AND DEVELOPMENT

We go to extraordinary lengths to help you make the most of your talents. The details of your development will be tailored to your particular needs and aspirations. But broadly speaking, here's what you can expect:



TOTAL IMMERSION

In weeks one to four, your induction will cover everything from the sectors we work in to the methodology we use. You'll then apply the skills you've gained as part of a live project team. After a few months, you'll return for a two day-refresher, to share your experiences and build on what you've learnt.

ON-THE-JOB LEARNING

We believe the best way to learn is by doing. From week five onwards, you'll be working with a client on a project, and effectively running your own work stream.

REGULAR FEEDBACK AND SUPPORT

You'll sit down for weekly one-to-ones with your line manager and peers. You'll also be assigned a development manager who helps you to grow in your role and progress in your career.

TRAINING WITH IN-HOUSE EXPERTS

Throughout your career here, you'll benefit from internal training workshops, including a three-day course in your first year that's designed to develop your efficiency and engagement skills. You'll also receive ongoing support from our leadership team, senior consultants and other experts across the business.

ONLINE LEARNING PLATFORM

Our on-demand portal allows you to download resources and share best practice with others. It's a one-stop-shop that offers everything from TED Talks to blogs to real-life case studies.

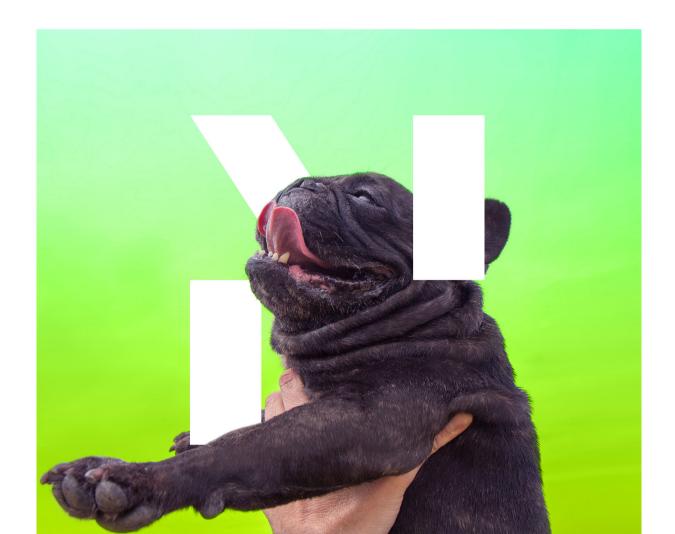
A CLEAR PATH TO SUCCESS

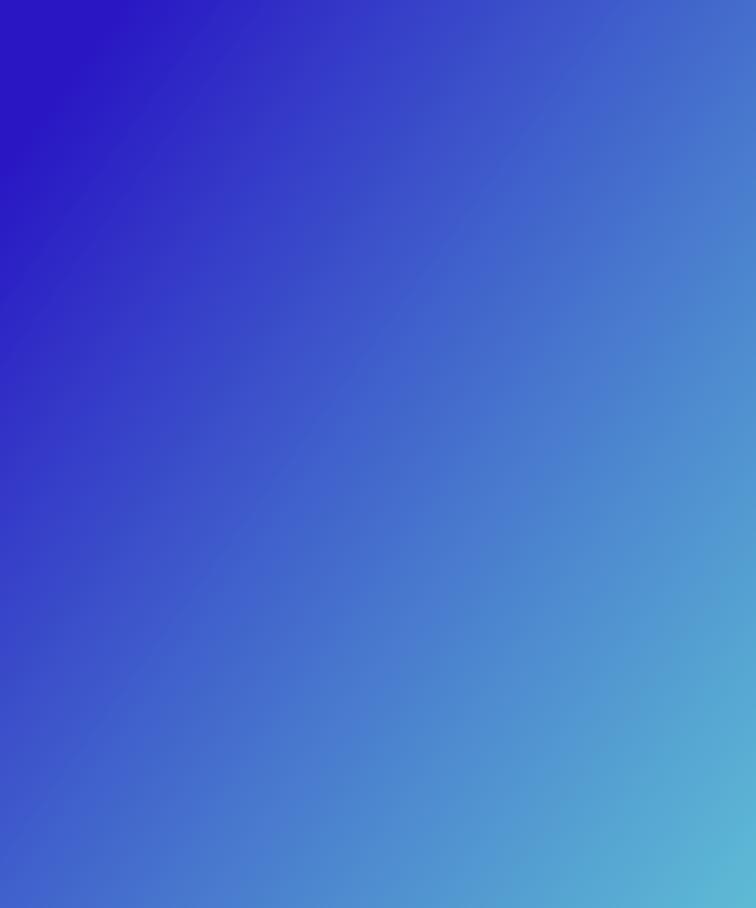
